



## **Our Stance**

At BenHale Academy, **cell phones are not part of the school day**. While we understand many learners' own smartphones, they are a major distraction and can cause disruption to teaching, learning, and discipline.

# **Key Rules (Easy to Remember)**

- 1. No Phone Use During School Hours
  - School time is **07h45 14h30**.
  - o Phones may not be used in class, at recess, or anywhere on campus.

## 2. "Out of Sight" Rule

- Learners may carry a phone, but it must be switched off and kept out of sight (e.g., in a bag).
- o A phone must **never be visible** during the school day.

### 3. Confiscation & Consequences

- o If a learner is caught using a phone, it will be **confiscated immediately**.
- The phone will only be returned at the end of the week it was confiscated.

#### 4. Parent Communication

- Parents who need to contact their child during school hours must call the Administration Office.
- Staff will either:
  - Bring the learner to the office to take the call, OR
  - Deliver the parent's message to the learner promptly.











## 5. Tablets & Laptops

- May be used **only with the teacher's permission** for school-related tasks (e.g., Google Classroom).
- o If misused (e.g., social media, messaging apps), the device will be confiscated for the day.

## **Why This Matters**

- Protects learners from distraction.
- Reduces risks of **cyberbullying** (a criminal offence under South African law).
- Helps learners focus on learning, not devices.
- Teaches **responsible and disciplined use** of technology.

#### **Additional Recommendations**

- Clear storage requirement: Learners must keep phones in their school bag during the day (not pockets).
- After-school rule: Phones may only be used once the learner has left the campus.
- Repeated offences: Consider stricter penalties after a second offence (e.g., parent must collect the phone, or longer confiscation period).
- Cyber safety clause: Reiterate that any form of cyberbullying, sexting, or inappropriate digital conduct linked to school will face serious disciplinary and even civil action in extreme cases.
- Parent partnership: Please support this policy by not messaging your child/ren during school hours.
