

Administering Medication - Parent Consent Form (2026)

Why this matters?

To keep your child safe, BenHale Academy can only give medication to a student if we have clear written consent from a parent/guardian. Parents may also choose to come to school to give medication themselves.

Our Rules for Medication at School

- 1. Written Consent No medicine will be given without this signed form.
- 2. Original Packaging Medication must come in its original child-proof container, labelled with:
 - Your child's full name
 - Dosage instructions
- 3. Storage Medicine will be stored safely (locked container or fridge if required) and returned when the course is complete.
- 4. Measuring Devices If liquid medicine is provided, parents must supply a marked dropper/cup/syringe.
- 5. **Daily Record** Staff will record every dose given. You will receive a copy at the end of each day.

Prescription Medication

- Will only be given exactly as per the doctor's/pharmacy label.
- Parent instructions cannot contradict the label.

Over the Counter (OTC) Medication

- May be given if parents provide written instructions.
- Must follow the dosage on the product label.
- Parent instructions cannot contradict the label.

Important!

Parents must inform the school if their child has taken any medication before arriving at school.
