- Grades R-6 → Tablet (10.1 inch, 32GB, Wi-Fi, case. Optional -stylus and or Bluetooth keyboard)
- Grades 7–12 → Laptop (Core i3, 4GB RAM, 256GB SSD, Office 365, antivirus, bag, earphones)
- IT Students Gr 10-12 → Laptop (Core i5, 8GB RAM, 256GB SSD, Office 365 with Ms Access, antivirus, bag, earphones)

Grades R-6

Device Required: Tablet

- **Display**: 10-to-11-inch Full HD
- **Storage:** 64GB is the current baseline for most Android and Apple tablets, giving enough room for school apps, e-books, and projects without constant storage warnings.32GB is the minimum and is acceptable.
- **RAM (Memory)**: 4-6GB
- Connectivity: Wi-Fi + Bluetooth (no SIM card required)
- Extras:
 - Protective case (strongly recommended)
 - o Stylus (helpful for handwriting/drawing) but not necessary
 - Bluetooth keyboard (optional for Grades 4–6)

Note: Android or Apple tablets are suitable – choose what suits your family best.

◆ Grades 7–12

Device Required: Laptop

- Screen: Full HD (1920 × 1080 resolution, 13 to 15-inch screen)
- CPU/Processor: Dual Core Intel i3 or AMD Ryzen 3
- RAM (Memory): 4GB minimum (8GB recommended for IT students in Grade 10-12)
- Storage: 256GB SSD
- Connectivity: Wi-Fi Dual Band, Bluetooth
- Software:
 - Windows 11 Home, 64-bit (Windows 11 Pro for IT students in Gr 10-12)
 - Microsoft Office 365 (Word, Excel, PowerPoint and MS Access for IT students in Gr 10-12)
 - PDF reader
 - Antivirus (ESET NOD32 preferred)

Extras:

- Protective carry bag
- Earphones/headset
